Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 3 (1 section each for Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively).The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 12. The total number of sections taken together for classes XI and XII should not be more than 1/3 of the number of section allowed including Bal

	Vtika. Any further increase shall require prior permission of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with the affiliation Bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 sq ft dimensions.
2	The computer lab does not have proper infrastructure (no AC) and no appropriate seating arrangement (plastic stools). Hence the school is directed to upgrade the computer lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
3	Composite lab is understocked. It does not have permanent workstations separately for Physics, Chemistry and Biology sections with appropriate fixture like piped gas supply on the demonstration tables, no appropriate seating facilities (plastic stools), no sufficient storage facilities. Safety features like exhaust fans and emergency exit are not seen in Composite lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoPs issued by the Board and submit the videographic compliance within 3 months.
4	Chemistry lab does not have sufficient storage facility, no piped gas supply on demonstration table, no appropriate seating facilities (plastic stools). Safety features like exhaust fans and emergency exit are not seen in Chemistry lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
5	Biology lab does not have sufficient storage facility and no appropriate seating facilities (plastic stools). Hence the school is directed to upgrade the lab as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
6	The books in library is not properly organized. Reading area for students in library are inadequate and there is no reading space for staff. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months.
7	The building safety certificate dated 16-05-2023 uploaded by the school does not have the number of floors and validity period. Hence the the school is directed to obtain fresh building safety certificate mentioning number of floor of the building and the validity period and upload the same on SARAS portal within 3 months.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Noida within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the

conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.

3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
